### 2008 First American Dendrochronology Conference – AmeriDendro 2008 – Student Paper and Poster Competition

The First American Dendrochronology Conference - AmeriDendro 2008 – will take place June 23-27, 2008 at the University of British Columbia in Vancouver Canada. The conference is intended for anyone interested in tree-ring research and its application in climatology, environmental sciences, archaeology, geology, resource management, conservation, policy, and society. Students are especially encouraged to participate in the conference.

Awards for the best paper and poster are planned to recognize outstanding student research. Competition for these awards is open to undergraduate and graduate students (including those receiving their Ph.D. within a year after the dissertation defense). Six awards are planned in total with separate awards for poster and paper presentations at each academic level (undergraduate, master, doctoral).

To be considered for the awards, the student must be either the sole author or the primary author of the paper, and must be the presenter at the meeting.

Judging criteria for the awards include: the significance and originality of the research question, the creativity and the quality of the methodology, the validity of the conclusions drawn from the results and the clarity of the presentation.
